In the Minburi district of Thailand, a small center made of wood is currently looking after more than 45 children. These children come from poor backgrounds and some are orphans. Parents do not have the means to send them to school, so they send their children to this center. There are two care takers who cook two meals a day to feed the children. The Municipality provide some funding for the center. But, the center is in urgently need of books and a play ground. We need to flatten the surface before we build the play ground. Four or five major pieces of equipment including a slider are needed for the playground. The cost will be around \$2,000. We are requesting the Rotary Club of Irondequoit to fund this project. We will mention the contribution of the Rotary Club of Irondequoit towards building of the playground in all our communications.
